1. OVERVIEW OF THE PROGRESS

The project was executed in two primary phases (Czech Republic and Italy), successfully delivering 21 distinct events and meeting all established milestones.

Phase 1: Velká Bystřice (Czech Republic) Activities were synchronized with the city's 750th anniversary to maximize reach.

- Cultural Diplomacy: Performances by the Italian Youth Band (30 musicians) and the Campanella Choir (50 choristers) reached over 500 spectators
- Heritage Transmission: A Traditional Costume Parade involved 1,400 participants (including 600 in costume), serving as a measurable indicator of intergenerational engagement.
- Gastronomic Exchange: Italian food stands engaged ~600 visitors, utilizing culinary traditions as a tool for informal social dialogue.

Phase 2: Alfianello (Italy) The return leg focused on institutional sustainability and social innovation.

- Strategic Governance: A Round Table involving 70 stakeholders (mayors, school officials, youth councils, associations, students) culminated in the signing of the Joint Collaboration Manifesto.
- Inclusive Innovation: A joint performance between the Czech delegation and the "Si Può Fare Band" (30 musicians with disabilities) demonstrated the universal power of music for social integration.

The action achieved significant quantitative and qualitative results:

- Transnational Mobility: Facilitated the exchange of 140 "cultural ambassadors" (86 Italians, 54 Czechs)
- Social Inclusion: the participating youth with disabilities reported an increased sense of self-efficacy and European belonging
- Institutional Legacy: The Joint Manifesto provides a legal and programmatic framework for cooperation, ensuring the continuation of the project in the future
- Citizen Engagement: Total direct reach exceeded 2,500 people (including spectators and stand visitors), far surpassing initial estimates for both municipalities.
- Educational Mobility: Guided visits to Olomouc, Cremona, and Brescia involved 144 international participants, focusing on shared European history and UNESCO heritage
- Digitalization and Memory: The inauguration of the photo exhibition and the digital documentation produced serve as a historical archive and a permanent tourism promotion tool for both municipalities.

Impact on Target Groups:

- Youth & Associations: Participants developed essential soft skills, including international logistics and multilingual communication. Local musical groups modernized their repertoires through cross-border collaboration.

- Local Authorities: The project enhanced administrative capacity for managing EU-funded initiatives and formalized a "bottom-up" approach to European policy-making.
- Change and Innovation: The project successfully introduced inclusive practices into the traditional twinning model, proving that European heritage-based events can serve as vehicles for modern social integration.

European Dimension and Added Value: The project provided a tangible experience of "Unity in Diversity." By leveraging the 750th anniversary of Velká Bystřice, the action magnified the visibility of EU values to a broader demographic. It successfully replaced abstract notions of European citizenship with personal connections, effectively breaking down cultural stereotypes through shared experiential activities.

All primary objectives were achieved on schedule and within the allocated budget. There were no significant deviations. Participation rates in the Czech Republic were higher than anticipated, providing additional added value to the "Active Citizenship" and "Community Continuity" indicators.

The TR.A.VEL. project concludes as a benchmark for small-scale twinning initiatives. It successfully transitioned from an "event-based" exchange to a "relationship-based" strategic model. The primary legacy is a reinforced social capital and a formalized roadmap (the Joint Manifesto) that ensures the European identity fostered during this action will continue to yield social and cultural dividends for both communities in the years to come.

Communication was the strategic pillar of the “Tr.A.Vel - Harmonies of Traditions” project. It was designed not only to promote the specific events but also to raise awareness of the core values of European integration. A multi-channel strategy was adopted to effectively reach diverse demographic groups.

1. Analysis of Activities and Target Groups

Dissemination activities were diversified to ensure maximum inclusivity and reach:

- Youth and Adolescents: Engaged through direct meetings in schools and via Instagram, utilizing a dynamic visual language (stories, reels).
- Adult Population: Primarily reached through Facebook, via both the official project page and the institutional profiles of the partners (Municipality of Alfianello and the Velká Bystřice Cultural Center).
- "Offline" Target Groups (Seniors / Digitally less engaged): Reached through traditional channels such as posters displayed in local businesses and municipal offices, as well as in-person informative sessions.
- Local Public: Targeted through local press coverage and participation in regional television programs.

The sustainability of TR.A.VEL. is built on institutional commitment, educational synergy, and permanent visibility, moving from a single event to a structural partnership.

- Institutional Framework (Joint Manifesto): The signed Joint Collaboration Manifesto formalizes the partnership, ensuring that cooperation continues as a permanent fixture in the administrative and cultural agendas of both municipalities.
- Continuous Institutional Dialogue: The two municipalities maintain an ongoing relationship throughout the year, sharing best practices in local governance, social inclusion, and tourism beyond the specific project dates. Next institutional travel will be in February when an institutional delegation of Alfianello will go to Velká Bystřice during the "Bystřický masopust".
- Digital Connectivity: Dedicated social media channels have been established to serve as a permanent "digital bridge," allowing citizens, associations, and young people to maintain direct contact and coordinate future informal initiatives.
- Permanent Visibility (Photo Exhibition): The project's legacy is preserved through a physical and digital photo exhibition. This archive serves as a permanent promotional tool, showcasing the project's achievements to the public and keeping the European dimension visible within the local communities.
- Basis for Educational Synergy: The project has successfully laid the groundwork for potential future cooperation between local schools. By establishing initial contacts between educational administrators during the exchange, both communities are currently exploring the feasibility of student mobility programs and collaborative academic projects to involve the next generation.

By combining formal agreements with educational and digital tools, the TR.A.VEL. project ensures that the European values of solidarity and intercultural dialogue remain active and self-sustaining for years to come.
